

DEFINITIONS

LOCAL TRAFFIC – Traffic generated by local movements such as school runs, local shopping trips, agricultural vehicles, etc.

STRATEGIC TRAFFIC – Traffic whose origins and destinations are between large towns and cities which may be beyond the area under consideration, for example, HGVs transporting freight.

CORRIDOR - Corridors are an interim step in the assessment process moving from broad coverage of the whole study area towards the detailed design of the final route. The corridors permit some room for manoeuvre in developing routes to avoid constraints within the corridors.
